World Language Department

Spanish, **French**, and **German** are the World Languages that we offer for study at UMASD. Our World Language curricula are aligned with ACTFL standards. In the area of communication, students are expected to develop interpersonal, interpretive, and presentational skills. Students also investigate cultures, connections, comparisons, and communities related to their target language.

High School

Students progress from level 2 through level 5/AP at the high school in all three languages. We also offer level 1 language classes in Spanish and French.

Dual enrollment in levels 4 and 5/AP are available through our partnership with Montgomery County Community College. Students can earn 3 credits each semester in these final two years of world language study, earning up to 12 college credits in World Language before graduating from high school.
