Dear Class of 2032,

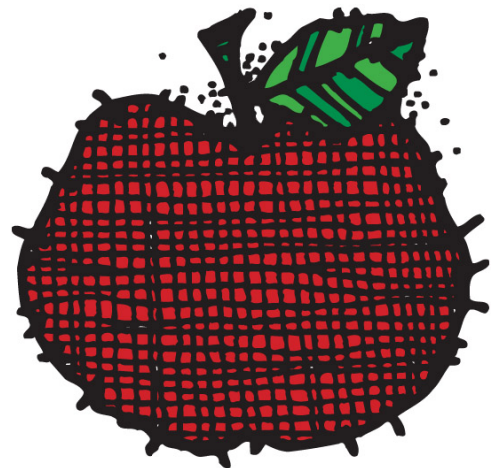
We are very excited to be your kindergarten teachers this year! We are looking forward to meeting you and learning all about you.

For the first day of school be sure to bring:

- **lunch or lunch money** (Student Meal Accounts and Free/Reduced Lunch applications are available at www.schoolcafe.com) - LABEL LUNCHBOX WITH NAME
- **2 healthy snacks** – CLEARLY LABELED (NAME and AM/PM – for example, yogurt should be eaten in the morning to make sure it does not spoil) **Please see the suggested snack list from the UMASD Elementary Handbook
- **change of clothes** for emergencies
- **name tag** (attached) – We'll be wearing the same one on the first day of school!
- a **backpack** that is big enough to fit a folder (a school age backpack, not preschool size)
- If your child is bringing water to class everyday, please be sure that the **water bottle** closes tightly and does not spill if it falls
- **over the ear headphones** (available at Five Below or Amazon for under \$10)
- a **SMILE!**

If you are able to provide them, the following supplies are needed in Kindergarten this year!

- big Elmers glue stick
- pair of child size scissors
- 24 count Crayola crayons
- smock or old tshirt
- pack of baby wipes
- paper towels
- box of tissues
- box of quart or gallon size Ziploc bags
