

Pennsylvania Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) Inquiry Form

P-EBT Card Inquiries

The purpose of this form is to submit inquiries regarding P-EBT for Pennsylvania.

In order to be eligible for P-EBT, a child must attend a school that participates in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) and receive free or reduced price meals.

P-EBT Card Issuance Dates

The P-EBT benefit issuance for current SNAP and TANF EBT cardholders will be complete by June 8, 2020, if your child was receiving free or reduced price meals prior to May 20, 2020. For free and reduced eligible school-aged students that are not SNAP/TANF or those receiving SNAP or TANF that became eligible for free or reduced price meals after May 20, 2020, white P-EBT cards are being mailed and should be received by the end of June 2020.
